The charity collecting buckets across the village on the day will go towards purchasing a water boiler for the communal area at Oakwood Park.

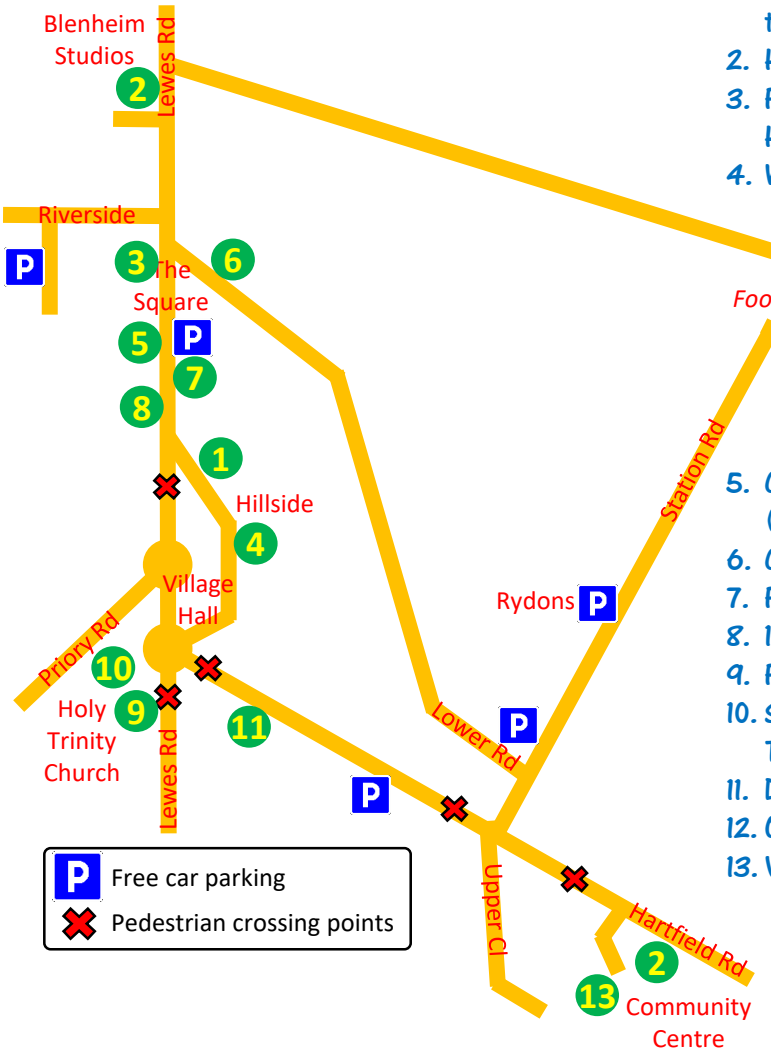
